

## Route description

## Ennora - Ängelsberg - Virsbo - Seglingsberg 23 km

- 19. Ennora. Here you'll find a lean-on shelter and an outhouse.
- 20. Ängelsberg. Here you'll find a swimming site and an outhouse. Also hostel, bed & breakfast, restaurant and visitor centre. Here is also the world heritage site *Engelsberg bruk*. It tells the history of the area and the ironworks.
- 21. "Oljeön" means "the oil island". The oldest preserved oil refinery in the world. You can take a guided tour and learn more about the interesting history of Oljeön. It's well worth a visit. It is not allowed to make fires or smoke here! Due to oil still being present in the ground.
- 22. Kalvön. Good place to take a pause with a lean-on shelter and fire pit.
- 23. *Virsbo*. Bring the canoe out of the water by the floating dock on the right-hand side, under the road bridge. Walk along the canal and put the canoe back in the water below the lock. From here, on the eastern side, it's approx. 600m to the village centre.
- 24. Swimming site and an outhouse.
- 25. Swimming site and an outhouse.
- 26. Seglingsberg. Warning! Strong current! Keep to the left-hand side heading into the canal. Power station is to the right. Bring the canoe out of the water by the floating dock on the left side, by the road bridge. Walk approx. 75m across the bridge. Put the canoe back in the water by the jetty. A further 200m downstream it's possible to pitch a tent, there's also a lean-on shelter and an outhouse.
- 27. There are lots of small, rocky islands approx. 1km downstream from the power station. **Keep** to the right-hand side as it sometimes rapids can arise here! If you paddle to the canal lock at *Fermansbo*, you'll find fresh water tap and a large, grassy area where you can pitch a tent.
